



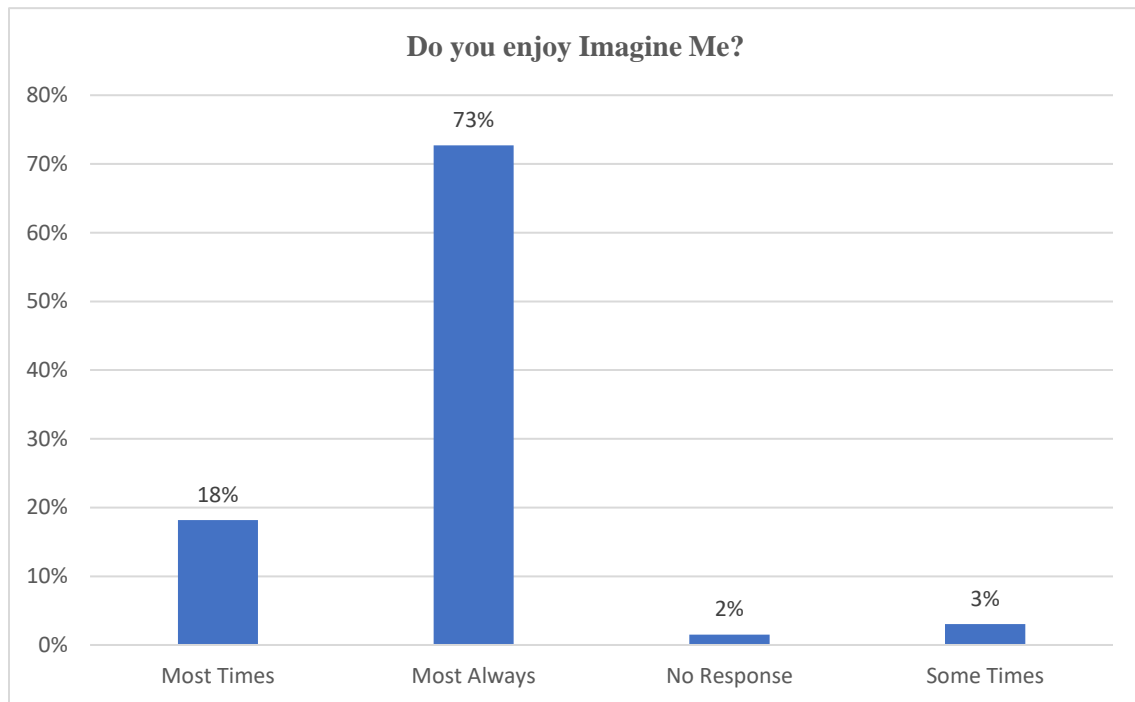
Imagine Me Middle School Programming at Calverton Elementary Middle School Participant Survey Results from 2007 - 2018

OVERVIEW:

The survey results are from the academic school years (August – June) beginning in October of 2007 (ASY 2007-2008) and ending June of 2018 (ASY 2017-2018). The surveys represent a total of 66 participants in grades 6th – 8th that participated in the after-school program at Calverton Elementary Middle School; many of whom participated in the survey more than one year, based upon the average participation rate of 2 to 3 consecutive years. These are yearly surveys and were conducted at the end of the school year. Below are some of the questions asked and their responses:

Question: Do you enjoy Imagine Me?

Responses: 91% of participants enjoy Imagine Me. 18% enjoy Imagine Me most times and 73% always enjoy Imagine Me.

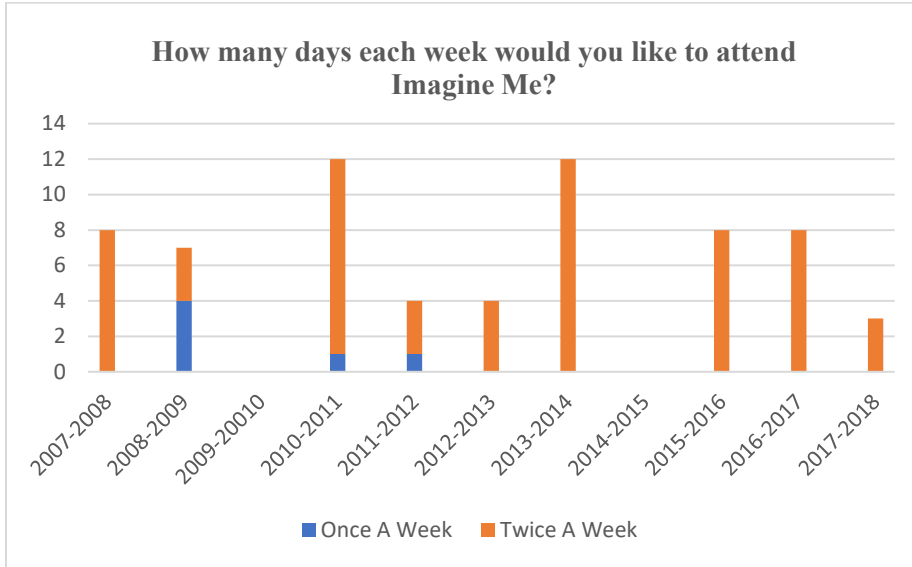




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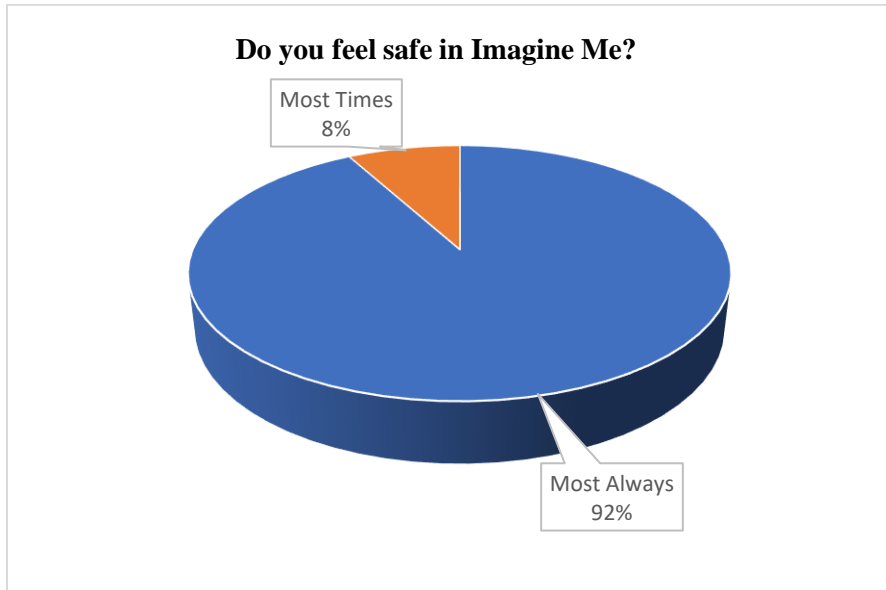
Question: How many days each week would you like to attend Imagine Me?

Responses: Year over Year, Imagine Me girls would like to attend sessions more than just once a week.



Question: Do you feel safe in Imagine Me?

Responses: Imagine Me girls feel safe in Imagine Me 100% of the time.

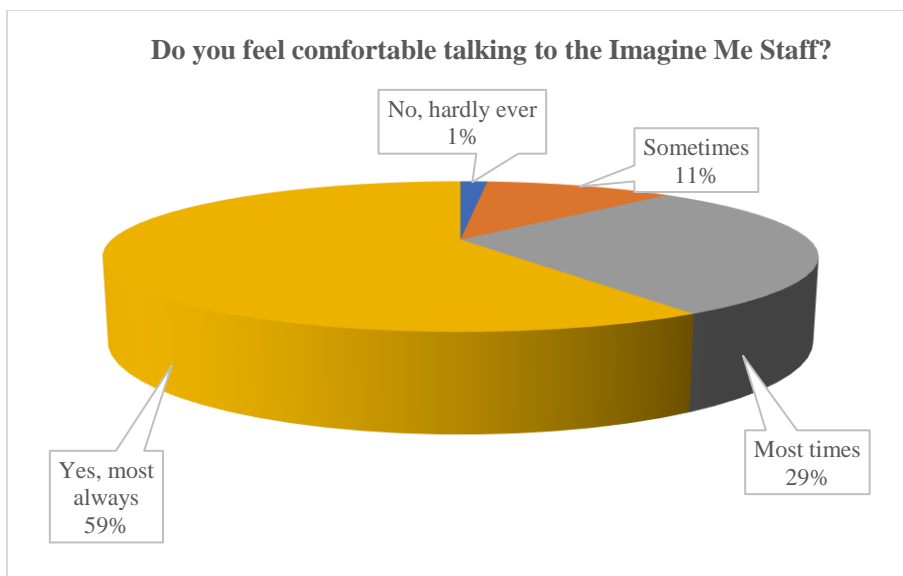




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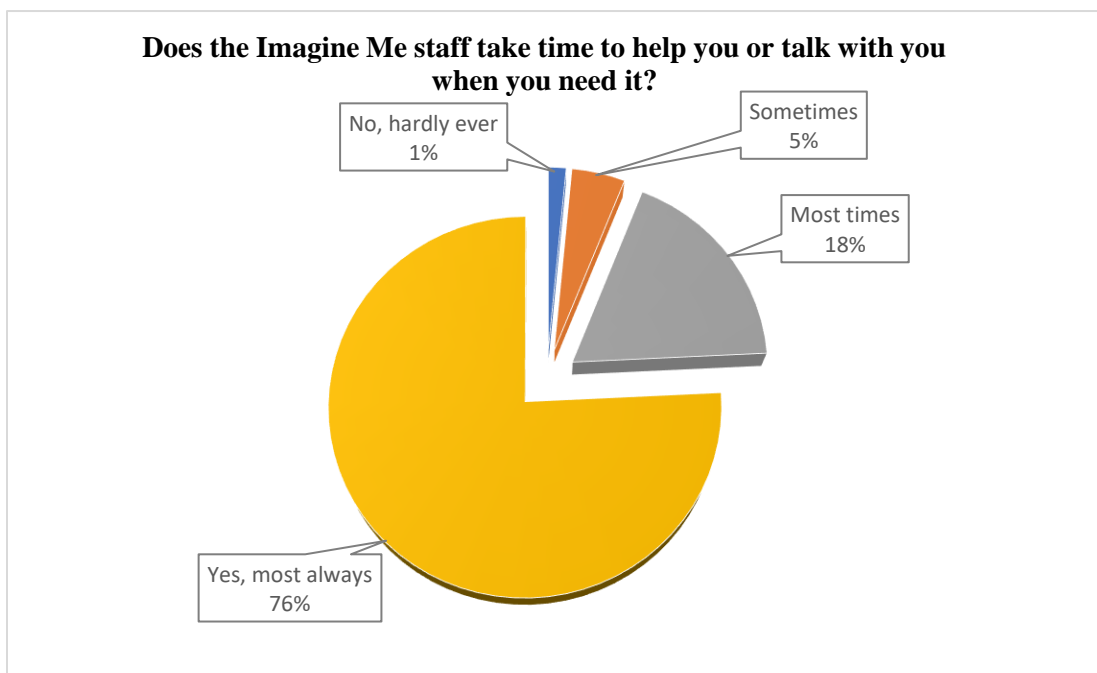
Question: Do you feel comfortable talking to the Imagine Me staff?

Responses: 88% of the girls are comfortable talking to Imagine Me staff. Of the 88%, close to 60% of the girls are always comfortable talking to staff.



Questions: Does the Imagine Me staff take time to help you or talk with you when you need it?

Responses: 94 % of Imagine Me girls feel that staff take time to help them or talk to them when needed. Of the 94%, 76% of girls feel staff is always helpful and take time out to talk.

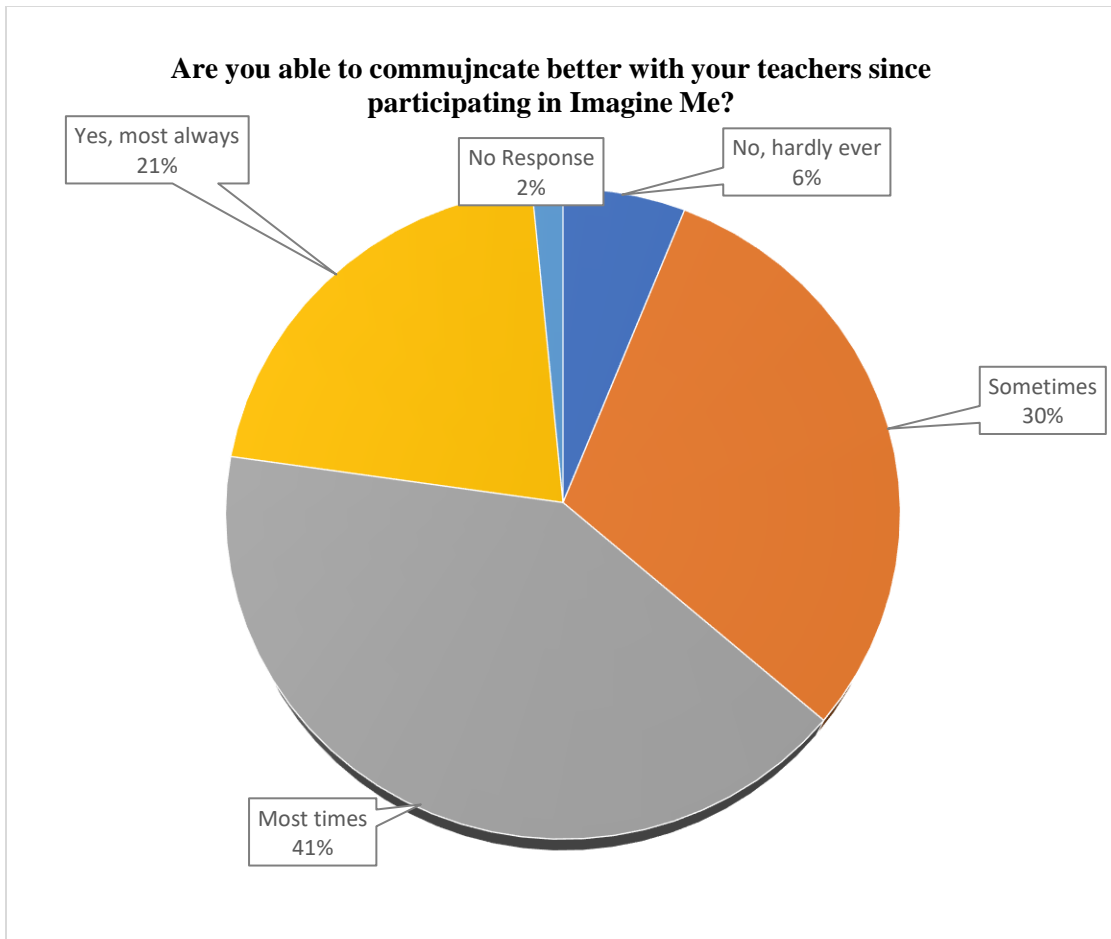




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Question: Are you able to communicate better with your teachers since participating in Imagine Me?*

Responses: 62% of Imagine Me girls are better able to communicate with teachers (most times/most always) as a result of participating in Imagine Me.

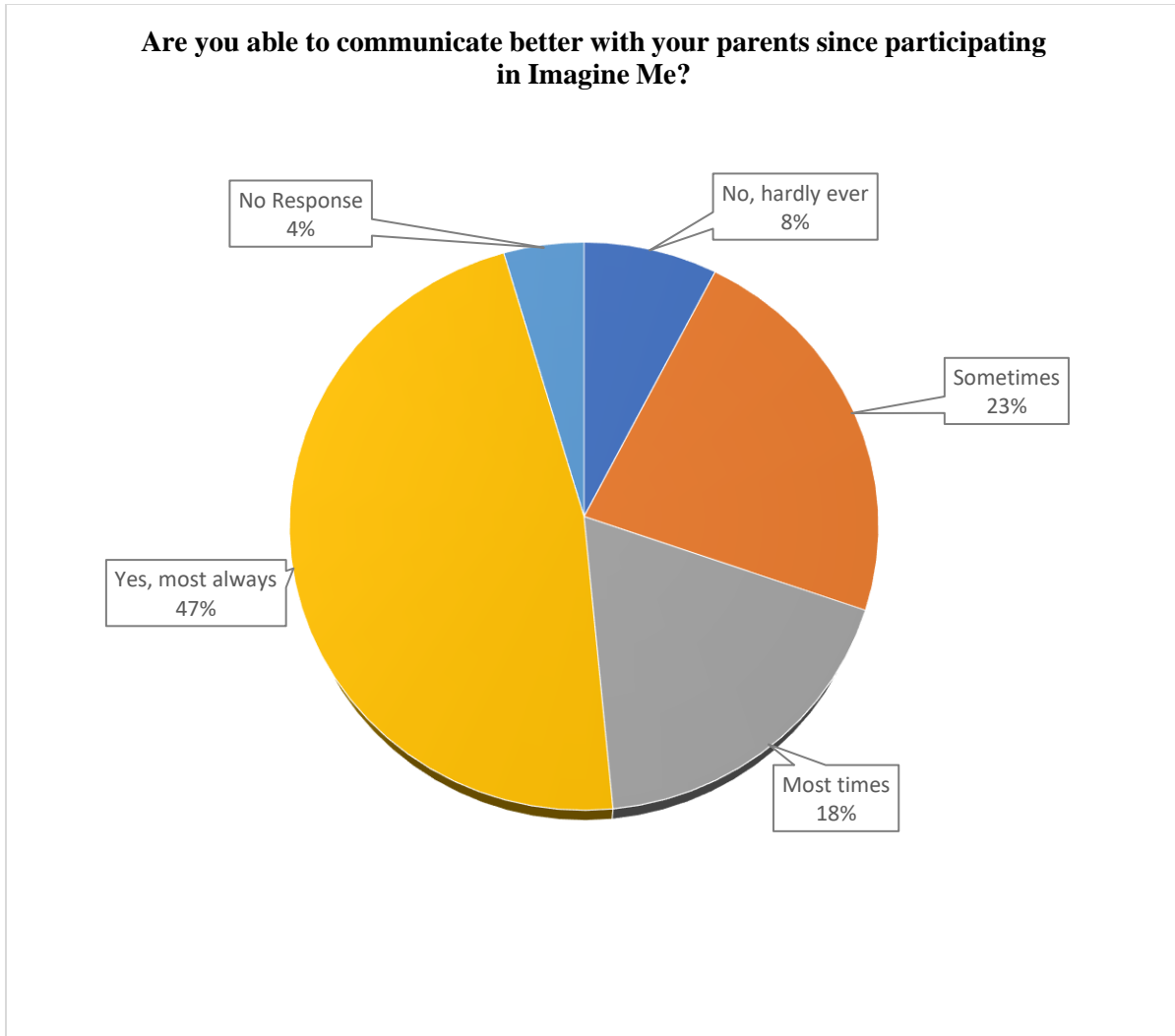




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Question: Are you able to communicate better with your parents since participating in Imagine Me?*

Responses: 65% of girls participating in Imagine Me are (most times/most always) better able to communicate with parents.

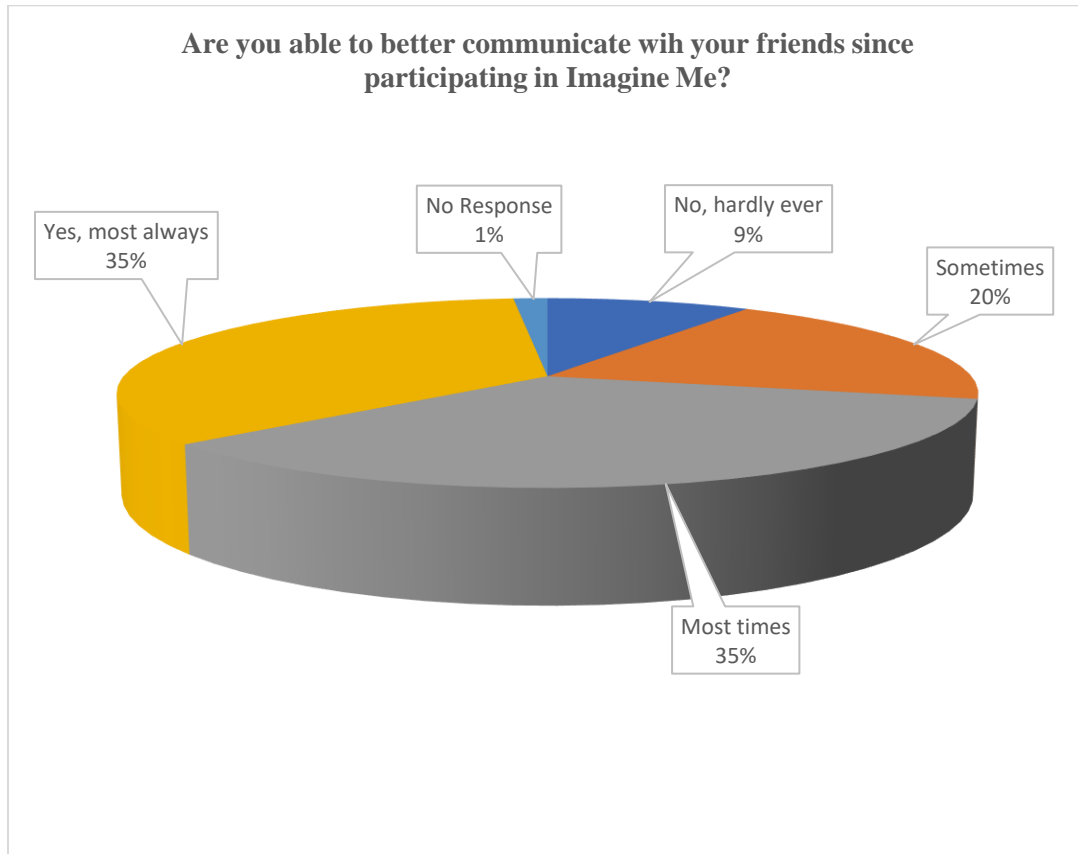




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Question: Are you able to communicate better with your friends since participating in Imagine Me?*

Responses: 70% of girls participating in Imagine Me are better able to communicate with friends.

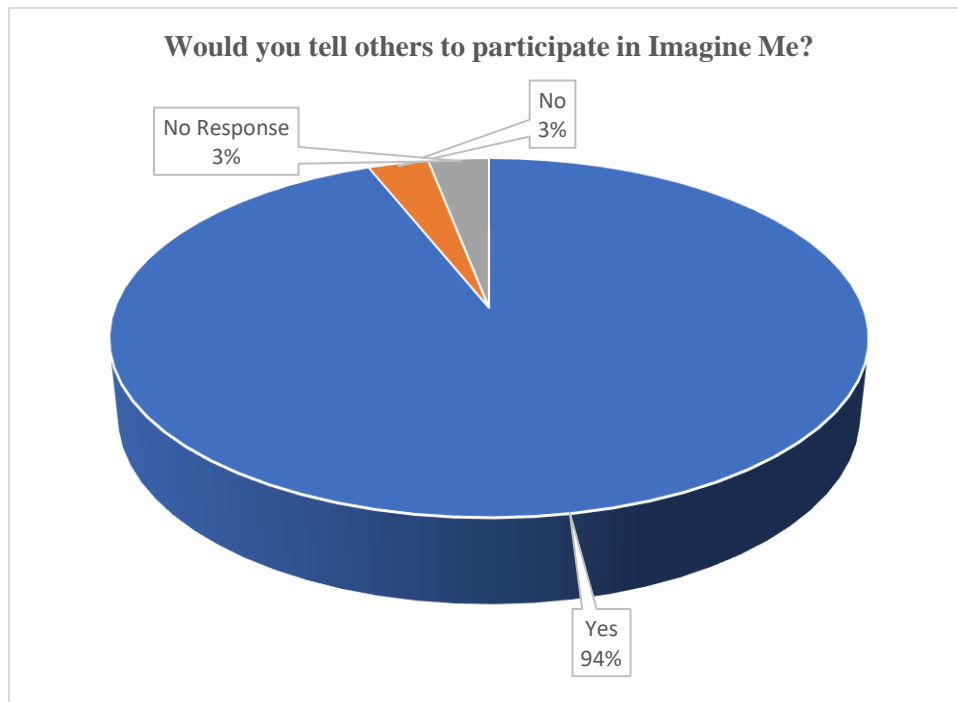




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Question: Would you tell others to participate in Imagine Me?

Responses: 94% of the girls participating in Imagine Me would tell others to participate. *Note: The no response by the participant was because she wanted to keep the circle of Imagine Me friends she had and did not want to include any others.*



*Note: As a result of the participant survey results, Imagine Me has implemented additional tools to measure participant progress socially, emotionally and academically, one of which includes an individual development goal and planning chart that is updated monthly and completed with a one-on-one/group mentor.
